

It offers over 125 titles published from the late 1960s to the present. With the global rise in the popularity of zine creation, RAPMM features titles published in multiple regions and languages, as well as long and short publication runs. Each title—presented in full text, cover-to-cover—provides a first-hand account of local popular music scenes through articles, interviews, album and concert reviews, and record label histories.



RAPMM is carefully curated to represent a diverse range of writing tones, perspectives, design styles, and creative uses of publishing technologies to share popular music histories. The collection safeguards the do-it-yourself (DIY) practice of fanzine making while preserving the unique contents about popular culture, design, fashion, and politics.
